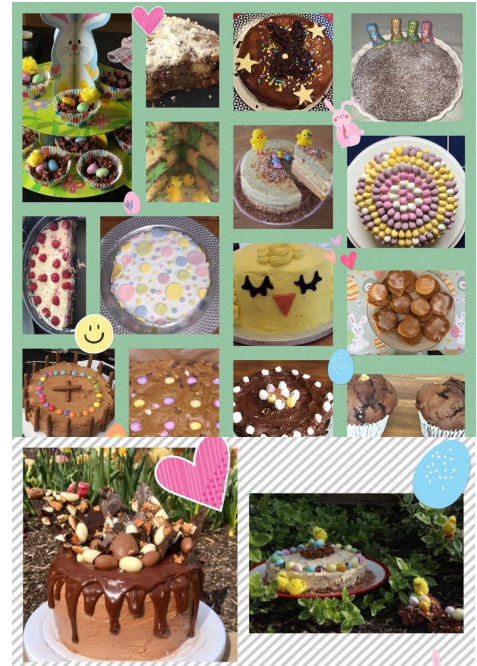
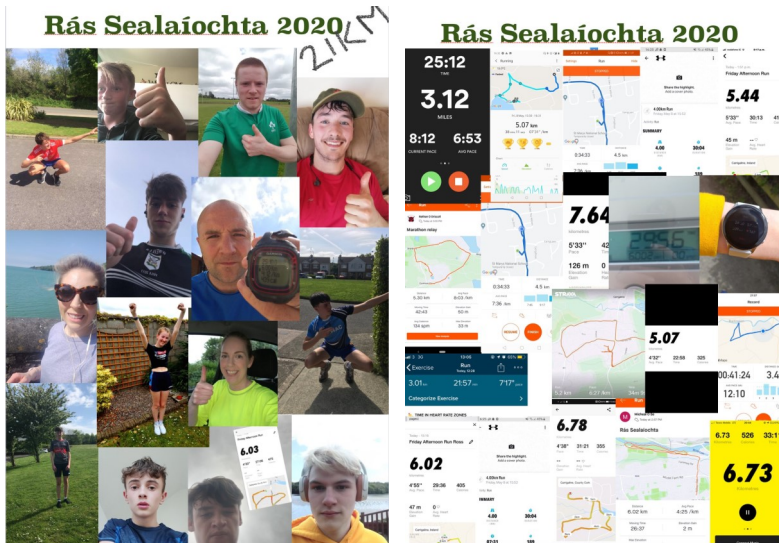

Lá stairiúil a bhí ann ar an 14ú Feabhra nuair a bhuamar Craobhchomhórtas Peile Sinsear na Mumhan. Imríodh an cluiche ar pháirc uile aimseartha Pháirc Uí Chaoimh i gcoinne Coláiste Daibhís Mala.

The Senior Football team made history on February 14th winning the Senior E Munster Football Championship in our first year competing. The game was played on the all-weather pitch in Páirc Uí Chaoimh against Davis College Mallow.

Two key moments encapsulate the performance. Liam Mac Siúrtáin, a third year student playing at senior level scored the first point of the game showing that our numbers and age profile never discourages the team. Secondly, Chris Ó hIarlaithe's selfless heroism in the second half prevented a certain goal, keeping the game under control. This showed the relentless nature of the team.

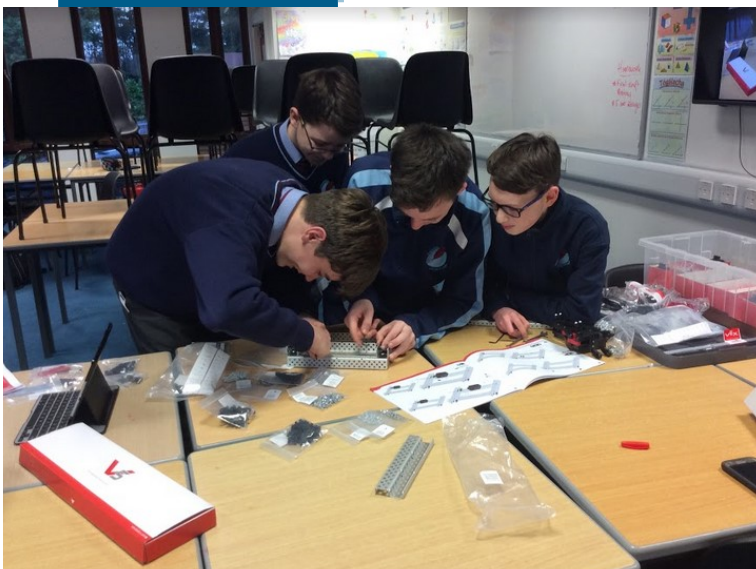

Equipment arrived in November and the team, directed by Máistir Ó Céilleachair, set about building their robot by meeting each week.

There are eight members on the team and each member has an individual role. Some are in charge of coding, working with the 'V5 Blocks' system. They were therefore tasked with programming the motors and linking the remote to the robot.

Others were involved in building the robot itself, working with the frame, wiring and overall structure. A well-built robot was necessary so to perform tasks in competition and withstand other robots.

On the day of the competition, we gained valuable insight into competition protocol and the standards that can be achieved with more experience. Thankfully, while our design was simple, it worked effectively throughout the day.

By reaching the quarter-final stage on the day, we qualified for the national stage. We look forward to the next step in the adventure

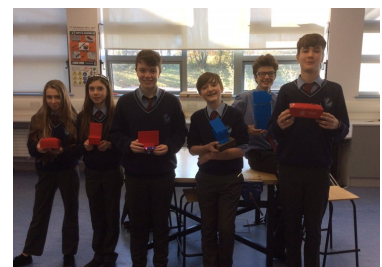


Cuairteanna Eolaíochta

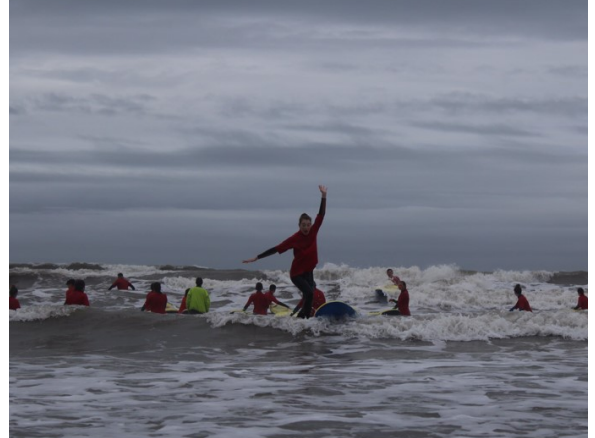
