



VEHICLE PARKING POLICY FOR STUDENTS

Gaelcholáiste Charraig Uí Leighin Vehicle Parking Policy for Students is designed to safeguard the health and safety of all persons on the school grounds. Safe driving habits should always be observed.

- a) Driving to and from school is a privilege reserved for senior cycle students only who possess a full driver's licence.
- b) Students who drive to school should not leave the school premises at any time unless permission has been granted by the Principal or Deputy Principal.
- c) The student's car keys should be left in the office during the school day.
- d) There are no designated parking spaces for students on the grounds of the campus. Parking is available on the Ballinrea Road outside of the campus.
- e) The student assumes all responsibility for loss or damage to his/her car, its equipment, and its contents.
- f) Speeding, reckless operation, making excessive noise, etc. by any student may be reported to the relevant authorities.
- g) Cars must be locked in the morning and must not be entered or moved during the day without official permission.
- h) If a student remains late in school for extracurricular activities / after school tuition etc, the vehicle must remain parked until the student is returning home after these extra activities.

- i) Students are prohibited from eating, smoking, sitting in or loitering around the cars.
- j) Violation of these regulations may cause possible disciplinary action.
- k) In compliance with present planning regulations, there is no long-term parking at the front of the campus. Any breach of these regulations may be reported to campus management.

This policy was adopted by the Board of Management on December 14th, 2021.
It will be reviewed regularly, or as is required.
